## The Registration Process

Initial registration of projects and participants should take place by **21 January 2012** (unless alternative arrangements have been agreed with the Organizing Committee) – there is no limit, within reason, to the changes which can be made to a project, before the final registration change deadline of 9 March 2012. The initial registration should be accompanied by a brief description of the project.

Registration must be made using the Registration Form attached or available through the web site and must be submitted through the Science Fair Coordinator at your school.

The complete rules for the Science and Engineering Fair are available at the Fair website. In brief, the rules are as follows:

- Each project may have up to three team members. A student may enter only one project or a student can be a team member of only one project;
- The project must be the work of the team members alone. Participants can obtain guidance from others, but the participants must do the work themselves;
- Projects involving human subjects, vertebrate animals, pathogenic agents, controlled substances, hazardous chemicals or devices, human/animal tissue or recombinant DNA must be approved by the Fair's Science Review Committee;
- All projects entered in the Fair **must** include a display. All project displays **must** be accompanied by a report. The text of the report should be less than 10,000 words in length.

- The report should be written in English. (Reports from the French, Japanese or Russian Schools may be submitted in French, Japanese or Russian respectively as long as they are accompanied by a summary in English.);
- The majority of display areas will have a depth of 76 cm by 122 cm wide. If that is not sufficient for your project, contact one of the Science Fair organizers for assistance;
- Electrical Power: If power is required for your display, 220 volt single phase (50 Hz) power will be available, maximum of 500 watts.

## Science Fair Schedule

### Friday, March 16.

1800 to 2000 - Registration at AIS.  
Pick up your registration packet in the foyer.

### Saturday, 17 March

0830 to 1000 - Students arrive. Please be at your project display by 1000.  
1000 to 1200 - Interviews by at least three judges.  
1200 to 1400 -- lunch  
1400 to 1600 - Public Viewing. Stay with your project  
1600 to 1700 - Dismantling your projects.

## The Awards Banquet

The Awards Banquet will be held on the Thursday following the fair. As a participant in the fair you are invited to the Banquet: you can purchase additional Banquet tickets for family and friends the Banquet at registration or during the science fair. Adults and young adults can purchase additional tickets at approximately €20 each, and non-participating children (under 13) can attend for around €10 each.

The Awards Banquet will take place in the restaurant at the Vienna International Centre at 6pm. Information on the menu will follow at a later date.
